Zeina Daccache



Zeina Daccache is a Lebanese actress, theatre and film director and drama therapist.

She worked for the TV as an actress from 2003 to 2015. She is the founder and Executive Director of Catharsis - Lebanese Center for Drama Therapy and works as drama therapist in different settings (prisons, rehabilitation centers, etc.). Her work amended several laws in Lebanon. She is recipient of many awards given for her distinguished contributions to the field of social initiatives and services.

Director's bio-filmography

Zeina produced the pioneering artistic production "**12 Angry Lebanese**" with inmates of Roumieh Prison in 2009. This pioneering production as well as the documentary that emerged from the process received international acclaim (8 Awards) and led to the implementation of Law 463 in 2009 (the reduction of sentences for good behavior). In 2013, she created the play "Scheherazade in Baabda", with women inmates of Baabda prison where they shared their personal stories in an attempt to heal their wounds and hold up a mirror to Lebanese society about the oppression of women. Her 2nd feature documentary "**Scheherazade's Diary**" wins 10 international awards. In 2020, she finished the post-production of her third feature documentary "**The Blue Inmates**" about mentally ill offenders.
